Naperville, IL — Naper Settlement is one of the many museums and nature centers participating in the 19th annual Passport to Adventure, sponsored by the Kane-DuPage Regional Museum Association. This popular program is your ticket to the many amazing and exciting activities that museums provide to enrich our lives and communities. The program is designed for children between the ages of 4 and 12 and runs from Memorial Day through Labor Day.

Pick up a passport booklet at a participating museum, historical site, nature center or local library. The booklet has information about 50 museums, nature centers and historical sites from throughout the western suburbs. Fill the passport with as many stamps as possible. After visiting seven sites, participants can receive a general KDRMA prize from any museum; however, site-specific prizes are only given to the participants returning their book to the same location from where it was picked up. The fun doesn't have to end after Labor Day; keep your passport as a reference guide for exciting places to visit throughout the year. History comes to life at Naper Settlement, an outdoor museum village, located in downtown Naperville at 523 S. Webster St. Accredited by the American Association of Museums, Naper Settlement has 30 historic structures ranging from a rustic log cabin to an elegant Victorian mansion, listed on the National Register of Historic Places. During the summer months of April through October, hours are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday-Saturday and 1 to 4 p.m. Sunday. Admission is \$9 adults, \$8 seniors 62+ and \$6.50 youth 4-17.
